STRATEGY SESSION TO CHALLENGE BIO-WARFARE AGENT RESEARCH IN OUR COMMUNITIES

The US Department of Homeland Security and the Univ. of Cal. Regents are drawing up plans for dangerous new bio-warfare agent research labs at both the Livermore Lab main site and Site 300, Livermore Lab's high explosives testing range in Tracy.

We call upon individuals and Bay Area, Central Valley and other No. Calif. groups, local leaders and elected officials to join us in building a regional network to prevent the proliferation of dangerous bio-warfare agent research facilities.

Bio-warfare agent research may put the health and environment of the entire Bay Area and Central Valley at risk, and it provokes international concern due to its location inside US nuclear weapons labs.

We aim to reorient the Bush Administration's present biodefense policy, moving it away from exotic bio-weapon agent research and toward improving our public health infrastructure and strengthening the international Biological Weapons Convention.

The summit will open with a short educational panel, including a presentation from UCSF biologist Dr. Judith Flanagan, followed by a facilitated discussion of strategies and tactics.
