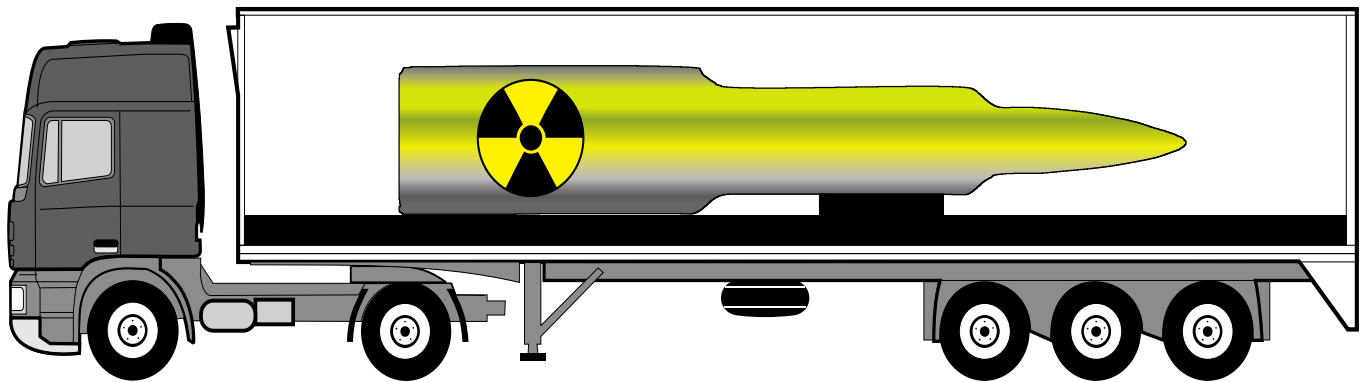


Tri-Valley CAREs invites you to join us in the Livermore Parade on Saturday, June 8, 2013
