

## Community Action Ideas to Increase Public Involvement in Superfund Decisions at the Livermore Lab Main Site & Site 300 @ State of Superfund Mtg. on 9/18/14

Idea/Action	Reason/Objective
1. TVC hosts annual SoS mtg. in Livermore + Tracy (Add'l idea: annual report card @ mtgs.)	Community edu; get latest info in accessible way; involve new folks in both communities
2. TVC speaks at your "house party"	Community edu; get latest info; involve your friends in an informal setting
3. Small teams meet with elected officials	Raise cleanup visibility; secure adequate funding to achieve cleanup
4. TVC requests Superfund tour of Site 300	Opportunity to see cleanup sites up close; better understand key sites with upcoming public comment periods
5. TVC requests Superfund tour of Main Site	Opportunity to see cleanup sites up close; better understand key sites where public comment can/should/will be occurring
6. TVC conducts perimeter tour of Main Site	Op to see major LLNL sites from fence line in a guided tour format
7. TVC requests hazardous waste facilities tour	Op to see waste storage and treatment areas; prepare for public hearing
8. "Affinity groups" form on topics of mutual interest	Self-facilitated roundtable discussion
9. Livermore and Tracy school clubs form (Add'l idea: HS & Middle Schools have leadership training)	Opportunities for discussion; new leadership
10. TVC meeting October 16 at 7:30 PM (library)	Opportunity to further develop Superfund plans
11. TVC provides community notice of 5-Year Reviews	Obtain more public comment on cleanup progress at specific areas of Site 300 & Main Site
12. Letter or petition to get key docs in Spanish	Better involve historically disenfranchised community voices; involve whole community
13. Letter or petition to reinstate CWG at Main Site	Restart institutional public involvement process
14. Letter or petition to start CWG at Site 300	Start institutional public involvement process
15. Petition to stop transport of plutonium bomb cores	Protect public health and enviro from new risks
16. Talk to EPA re: sponsoring advisory group(s)	Potentially open another avenue for community
