Proposed Action to INCREASE the weight/size of outdoor toxic bomb blasts.

- 100 lbs./day to 1,000 lbs./day (10x more)!
- 1,000 lbs./yr. to 7,500 lbs./yr. (7.5x more)!
- More than 121 hazardous substances included in the explosions, according to the lab!

The San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District has issued a preliminary decision to give Site 3000 permission to detonate these open-air toxic blasts. The air district's public hearing on Thursday, July 12th is our last and best chance to stop the project.
